SURVEYORS REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Cap. 417)

The Surveyors Registration Ordinance provides for a registration system for professional surveyors whereby those qualified and registered may be entitled Registered Professional Surveyors or designated RPS.

The Ordinance is designed to establish the registered status of the various divisions of surveyors and at the same time safeguard the rights of the consumer public.

Registration is open to a professional surveyor:

- (i) who is a Fellow or Member of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors; or
- (ii) who is a member of an institution, the membership of which is currently accepted by the Surveyors Registration Board as being of a standard not less than that of a Fellow or Member of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors; or
- (iii) who has passed such examination in surveying and other subjects and has received such training and experience as the Board may accept, either generally or in a particular case, as a qualification of a standard not less than that of a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors; and
- (iv) who has satisfied the Surveyors Registration Board that he has had one year's relevant professional experience in Hong Kong before the date of his application for registration; and
- (v) who is ordinarily resident in Hong Kong; and
- (vi) who is not the subject of an inquiry committee or a disciplinary order under Part IV of the Surveyors Registration Ordinance which precludes him from being registered under the Ordinance; and
- (vii) who satisfies the Board by declaration in writing that he is competent to practise in the relevant division; and
- (viii) who is a fit and proper person to be registered.

As stipulated in Section 13(3) of the Ordinance, the Board, in its discretion, may require an applicant to undertake a written examination to verify his knowledge of surveying if he is not a member of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors or his membership of a surveying body is not accepted as being a standard not less than that of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors.

Registration is valid for one year and is renewable annually. A fee is charged on every application for registration and renewal of registration, and a Certificate of Registration or Renewal of Registration will be issued.

The Ordinance makes provision for both removal of names from the Register and for disciplinary proceedings against any registered professional surveyors who commits a disciplinary offence. In the latter event, an enquiry committee may be established by the Board.

A person on the Register is entitled to describe himself as a "Registered Professional Surveyor" (in a qualifying division) and to use the initials "RPS" (in a qualifying division).

General Notes on Application

This form must be accompanied by documentation to prove the applicant's current membership of a recognized professional surveying institute or other body on the basis of membership of which this application for registration is made. All photocopies must be certified by a Registered Professional Surveyor.

Application Fee and Registration Fee

Fellows and Members of the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors

- 1. Application Fee (HK\$300 non refundable payable when submitting the form).
- 2. Registration Fee* (HK\$300 per division payable when submitting the form).

The Registration Fees will be refunded to unsuccessful applicants.

Members of recognized institutes other than the Hong Kong Institute of Surveyors

- 1. Search Fee and Application Fee (HK\$800 non refundable payable when submitting the form).
- 2. Registration Fee* (HK\$300 per division payable on subsequent demand notified to successful applicants only).
- * This registration fee covers the 12 months from the date of registration.

Renewal Fee

Renewals of registration will be charged at the prevalent rate (currently HK\$300 per division per annum).

This form must be accompanied by the appropriate fees on submission.

Notice to Applicants

Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance

- 1. An applicant is required to supply the data set out in the application form for the purposes of processing the application and maintaining a register of registered professional surveyors under the Surveyors Registration Ordinance. The register is open to the public's inspection under Section 11 (2) of the Surveyors Registration Ordinance. An application will not be processed unless all the requested data are supplied.
- 2. An applicant is required to verify his identity by production of his Hong Kong Identity Card to the Registrar.
- 3. Instead of presenting his Hong Kong Identity Card to the Registrar in person, an applicant may send a copy of Hong Kong Identity Card to the Registrar, provided that such copy is certified to be a true copy by a person who is a registered professional surveyor.
- 4. An applicant has the right to request access to and correction of his/her personal data. Any such request should be addressed to the Registrar of the Surveyors Registration Board at Room 1205, 12/F., Wing On Centre, 111 Connaught Road Central, Sheung Wan, Hong Kong.
